- a) Haemorrhage: blood oozes from mouth, nose, anus or sexual organs; black, thick, tar-like, rapidly decomposing. When best selected remedy fails to relieve the burning pain of carbuncle or malignant ulceration.
- b) it is indicated in strumous, debilitated haemorrhagic broken-down constitutions; during zymotic disease; tendency to carbuncle or blood boils. Haemorrhagic diathesis and malignant jaundice.
- c) Large horny corns on soles of feet; very sensitive when walking especially on stone pavements
- d) Sore, lame bruised feeling all through the body, as if beaten; traumatic affection of muscles
- e) Aphthous sore mouth, is worse from touch; eating salty or sour food; of cold people, often from plate of teeth. Cracked and bleeding tongue

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
