- a) Bad effect of shock from injury; surface of body cold, pale face blue lips profound prostration, surface cold to touch but cannot bear to be covered
- b) Bad effects from loss of vital fluids; haemorrhage from any broken-down condition of mucous membrane, blood oozes from weakened tissue; vital force exhausted.
- c) When burns tend to ulceration and ichorous discharges. Lacerated wounds from blunt instruments much sloughing of soft parts.

- d) Ailments from loss of vital fluids, especially haemorrhage, excessive lactation, diarrhea, suppuration, of malaria origin with mark periodicity.
- e) Dissecting wounds, especially if tendency is to become gangrenous; septic fever, marked prostration.
